August 30 & 31 - Ormiston College, Brisbane.

Eligible trampolinists should receive invitations, parents are asked to consider and respond as a matter of urgency. Nominations close July 19.

CENTRAL QUEENSLAND REGIONAL INVITATIONAL

So far this year, Vici Park has convened 2 regional invitational meets in term 1 & 2. There will be a term 3 Regional Invitational Trampoline competition.
